



MAJOR FUNDRAISER FACES HUGE CHALLENGES

The Dewberry Ag Society Heifer Raffle usually starts the year off by having volunteers attend Agrivisions hosted by the Lloydminster Exhibition Association. Then it's off to several area Bull Sales to introduce the new year of ticket sales. Once spring arrives our team can be seen at many auction sales around the region making face to face contact with potential supporters. What a difference this year of 2020 has made in the way we have approached our sales targets. We have been forced to amend almost all facets of this undertaking. The web page got an update to allow customers to pay on-line thru the PayPal app using a credit card. We created some pretty successful print ads that were sent around the province by mass mail out and in the Alberta Beef Producers magazine. Our volunteer base has been forced to become a little more tech savvy and many have learned a few more skills on the computer. We have also created some radio advertising for the first time that seems to be pushing the word further around the province and growing our sales in new areas.

We are very grateful to the Stingray Group of radio stations as they have helped us along the way. Beyond the paid advertising we did thru CFCW we have been very fortunate to be chosen for Stimulus Funding on all our local Stingray stations which got us free airtime with a value of \$2000. We have also been notified just this week that CFCW has also chosen us to receive stimulus funding in a similar amount. This will allow us two weeks more advertising in addition to the final week of paid ads. That means three solid weeks on CFCW!! We have also been advertising on over thirty FaceBook sites, and between that and the radio in a span of one week we sold OVER 500 tickets on the heifer lottery—not to mention all the 50/50's that helped grow that prize to over \$13,000!!! It has been challenging to say the least, but we are hopeful this final push to the end will bring our sales up to a "normal" level so we are able to meet our commitments with ATB
